- It is expected of you to ensure that the kitty always has access to food, clean water and any medical treatment it may need. Deworming is to be done regularly (every 6 months)
- **SHOULD YOU FOR ANY REASON IN THE FUTURE, BE UNABLE TO KEEP/CARE FOR THIS ANIMAL, YOU WILL CONTACT KPFF AND RETURN THE KITTY TO US FOR REHOMING.**
- **UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES ARE YOU ALLOWED TO SELL THIS KITTY OR TRANSFER OWNERSHIP TO ANYONE ELSE WITHOUT KPFF CONSENT!!!**
- Do you agree to contact us to return the animal should you not be able to look after him/her anymore?

**Kittens need to be collected in a SECURE carrier! No kittens will leave their foster home unless they have a secure carrier to travel home in.** Please put a soft blanket inside and another blanket to partially cover the carrier as kitties really do not like driving in cars and it stresses them out.



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**THE ADOPTION FEE INCLUDES: DEWORMING, 1<sup>ST</sup> VACCINATION, TESTING FOR FELV/FIV, STERILISATION AND MICROCHIPPING. KITTENS 2<sup>ND</sup> VACCINATION AND RABIES ARE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE NEW FAMILY AND IS FOR YOUR ACCOUNT. (UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED)**

## **IMPORTANT INFO WHEN BRINGING YOUR KITTY HOME. PLEASE READ**

Please ensure that you have the following for your new kitten/s before collecting your baby/babies.

1. Royal Canin Mother and Babycat Pellets (Kittens up to 4 Months Old) OR
2. Royal Canin Kitten Pellets (Kittens 4 months – 1 Year)
3. A Few tins of Royal Canin Mother and Babycat Mousse (Soft Food) OR Royal Canin soft food (sachet) OR
4. Pureed boneless and skinless chicken breast (boiled in some water no salt or spices and finely blended with some of the broth you cooked the breast in) This mixture can be made in advance and the frozen in an ice cube tray for easy serving.
5. A Secure Carrier and a blanket to cover your carrier while travelling (we have found it helps to calm them during your trip home)
6. A bed with soft fluffy blankets and a hot water bottle in case your little one is still small and do not have a friend to cuddle up to for warmth. Please remember to wrap the hot water bottle in a towel or blanket before placing it with your precious bundle to ensure they do not burn themselves.
7. A litter tray, litter and a scoop for cleaning. (Please remind them for the first day or two, every few hours where the litter box is)
8. TOYS AND A SCRATCHPOST!
9. Ample fresh water should be freely available daily.

We recommend a good veterinary prescribed food for your kitty to ensure optimal development and health. Your kitty will have been fed a balanced diet of Royal Canin and Chicken while in our care, so if you do decide to change your kitties brand of food, we urge you to gradually switch them over to the new brand. Add a little more of the new brand to the Royal Canin every day, until your kitty is 100% on the brand of your choice. A slow transition helps the little one's digestive system adjust to the new brand so no runny tummies and vomiting will occur if it is done correctly.

Please note that if you do decide to put a collar on your baby, we strongly suggest a ROGZ Quick Release collar for kitties. Kittens often get themselves stuck in the most awkward places and should their collar catch on anything and not be able to release, it could lead to suffocation.

It is also advised that your kitten is not allowed outside without supervision until they are at least six months old.

If you have older cats in your household please bear in mind that a slow and gentle introduction to the new family member is the sure way to go. It may take a couple of weeks or even a month or three for your cat to accept the new kitty. Always ensure that the older kitties get equal amounts of love and attention so they do not feel threatened or left out. When introducing to other animals - exchange of smell helps (Swopping blankets etc) and let them eat together in separate bowls a few metres apart, facing each other, play together to help



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bonding (feather stick)

Always ensure that young children are not left with the kitten without adult supervision.

If you have doggies in your household, a short supervised visit, a few times per day (well out of doggies reach) is encouraged until kitty has the ability to show the doggie who the new boss is.....

Please be on the lookout for the following in your kitten: Lethargy, continuous sneezing, diarrhoea, loss of appetite) Kittens are prone to getting tummy bugs and if a mixture of puree chicken and bland pumpkin doesn't stop diarrhoea after 24hrs, then a vet and antibiotics will be needed. (Diarrhoea can be fatal in a small kitten as they quickly become dehydrated).

Please ensure that vaccinations and de-worming is kept up to date to ensure your kitties health and well being. If you have any questions or simply need advice please do not hesitate to contact us. Please feel free to also send updates and pictures of your little one/s as they grow. We always love seeing them again.

We know that your new baby will bring you lots of love and joy.

#### **I HEREBY DECLARE THE FOLLOWING:**

- I will allow KPFF to inspect the adopted animal at any reasonable time in the future.
- I understand that it may take a while for my adopted pet to settle into his/her new home and I will give him/her a reasonable period of time to adapt to its new environment.
- I have never been convicted of cruelty to animals, export of animals; I have not been involved in breeding or any illegal trading of animals.
- In the event of myself adopting a kitten that is too young for sterilisation, I undertake to bring the kitten back to the vet of KPFF on the arranged date agreed on by both parties for sterilising.
- It is my responsibility to update the records of my pet's microchip with the said company.
- I am financially able to care for this animal and all their general medical needs.
- In the event that I don't comply with the rules of this contract, the animal may be immediately confiscated and I will be liable for any medical/rehabilitation costs that may arise.

#### **LEGAL DISCLAIMER**

**The animal is the property of Kempton Park Feral Felines (KPFF) and is rehomed purely at our discretion. We have the right to refuse an adoption without giving any reasons. KPFF cannot accept responsibility for the temperament/behaviour of this animal after rehoming, but pledge to always be honest and forthcoming about adult cats personalities to the best of our ability. Should any information rendered on this form to be found false/incorrect KPFF has the right to investigate and reclaim/remove the animal without notice or compensation of any nature.**
