- Under NO circumstances are any of the cats or kittens in your care allowed to be homed at your own discretion. ALL Kempton Park Feral Feline NPO 209-132 cat and kitten adoptions to be done ONLY by approval of the Directors after all adoption procedures has been approved by us.
- Under NO circumstances are kittens to be left at another person’s home or in another person’s care for whatever length of time unless it is with the prior approval and consent of Kempton Park Feral Felines NPO 209-132.

- Please notify us of any change in address. A second home inspection will then need to be done at your new residence.
- Any cats or kittens NOT placed into foster care by Kempton Park Feral Felines NPO 209-132, will NOT be the responsibility of Kempton Park Feral Felines No 209-132. Any cats or kittens taken in by yourself without prior consent and approval of the DIRECTORS (Lizeth de Villiers , Charmaine Damalis or Candice Kruger) of Kempton Park Feral Felines NPO 209-132 will remain your own personal responsibility to feed, provide veterinary care to and to find suitable homes.
- If you can no longer act as a foster home for cats or kittens kindly advise us of such intention, so that we can arrange an alternative foster home. Please allow up to 7 Days for this.
